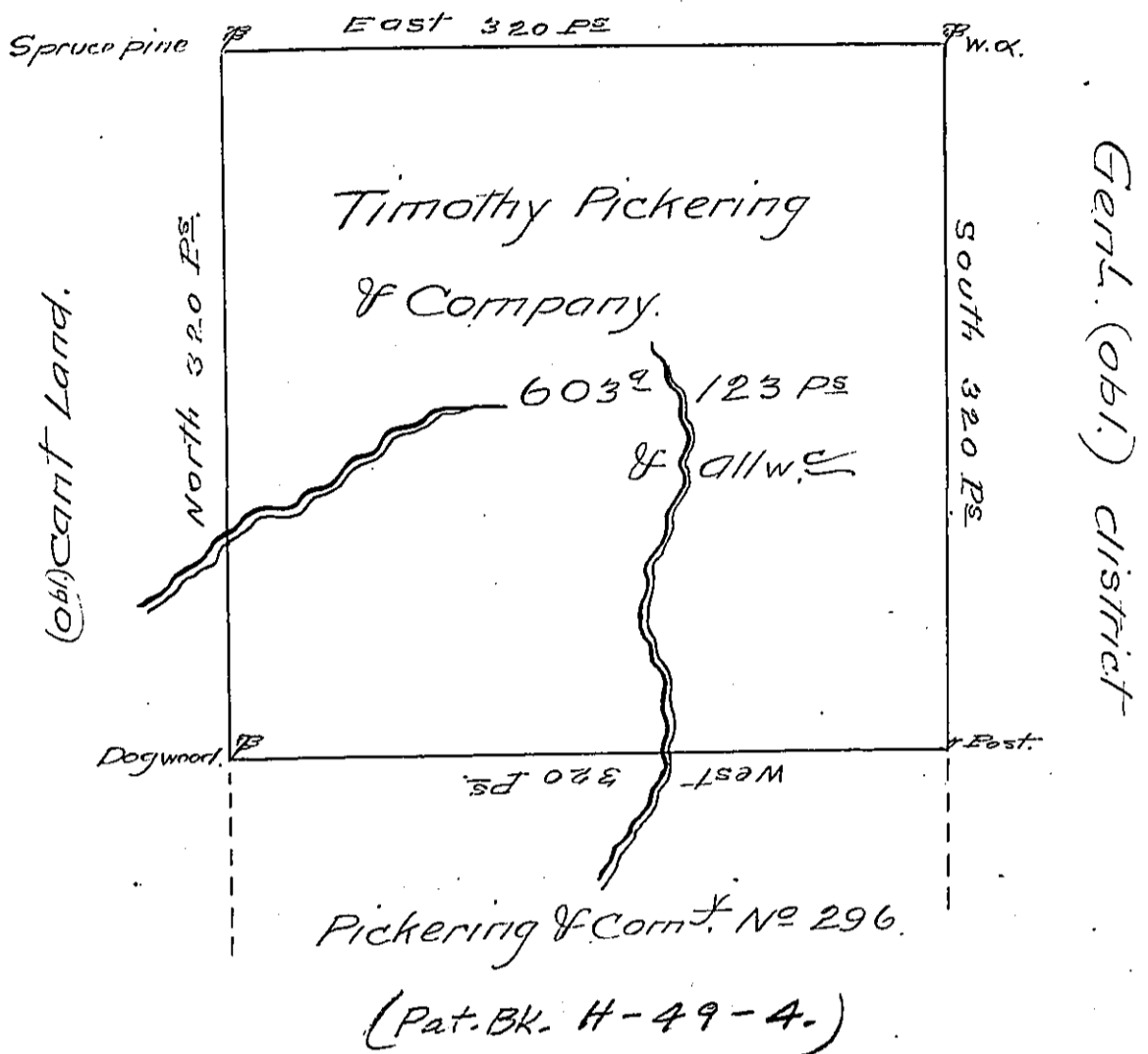


Vacant Land.



Surveyed to Timothy Pickering Samuel Hodgdon  
 Duncan Ingraham Junr & Tench Coxe on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of -  
 October 1785 the above described tract of six hundred  
 & three Acres & one hundred & twenty three perches -  
 and allow<sup>e</sup>. of six (obliterated) Situate between the 16<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup>  
 Mile trees on the East line of my District and ad-  
 joining said Pickering & Compan (obl.) other Land in  
 Northumberland County - By Warrant for 600 Acres  
 No. 307 dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1785 -
