



IN PURSUANCE of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following on a certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and thirty. Containing in Breadth East & West sixty feet on Dewberry Street, and in Length North and South Two hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Southward by Dewberry Street aforesaid, Eastward by Lot Number One hundred and Twenty nine, Northward by Strawberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number One hundred and thirty one. Return'd into the Secretaries—the 22^d day of December 1774 for John Patton by Warrant dated the 7th day of the same Month.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirtieth day of April 1906.
