



Situate in Warrior's Mark Township, Huntingdon County, containing fifty-eight acres, seventy seven perches and allowance of six per cent. Being a part of a larger tract of land, said to contain four hundred acres and allowance, which was surveyed on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1792, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Job Packer, dated the 20<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1792. This part re-surveyed and divided from the residue of said tract on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1861.
