Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Saml. Provines for 132 Acres & 25 perches, bearing date the 21 day of Feb^y. A.D. 1856. which was executed on the 26 day of June A.D. 1856; Angles formed with the true, instead of the magnetic meridian. From the best information I could obtain Isaac Miller, father of Andrew Miller had an improvement & an actual settlement on said Tract of land from the year 1770 & the heirs of the said Andrew Miller have sold the same & conveyed it by Deed Poll, to the said Saml. Provines who is the only claimant.
