Originally surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 120<sup>25</sup> Granted to Samuel Poak bearing date the 5<sup>th</sup> day of April 1773. Resurveyed by the old lines on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1814 at the request of Joseph Glenn the present owner who desired the same to be Returned for Confirmation.
