



Parry's Park Survey'd to Caleb Parry on the 3^d. Day of April 1775 Containing Three hundred Twenty Two Acres & Three Quarters of an Acre & Twenty seven Perches & allowance of Six & Ct. Situate about seven or eight Miles Northward of Brackin's Mill upon a Run leading into the South Side of Yellow Creek & adjoining the Lines of Hugh Law & Philip Becker in Westmorland County. By Warrant of the Sixth Day of March 1775.
