



Situate in East Providence township Bedford County containing 352 acres 45 perches and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c Surveyed & divided by James Piper Esq in the year 1847 being a part of a larger tract that originally contained 434 acres 153 perches & allowance surveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> of March 1793 in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Robert Morris dated the 27<sup>th</sup> of August 1788 and the part now returned is owned by two persons, namely, Solomon Feight owns 266 acres 130 perches & Daniel Davis owns  $85\frac{1}{2}$  acres which thay wish to get patented in one patent. Examined, copied, & returned for patenting the 28<sup>th</sup> of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1851.
