



Situate in West township Huntingdon County containing sixty one acres & eighty perches and the usual allowance the same being a part of a tract of land originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Alexander McCormick dated the 11th day of March AD. 1795 said to contain 328 acres & 4 perches & allowance this part resurveyed and divided from the residue of said tract the 29th day of November AD. 1851 by the request of John Huyett & Daniel Neff &c.
