Resurveyed April 24th 1835 for Joseph Magurk the present owner and said to contain 131^{ac} & 120^{ps} & all. examined and calculated Dec. 4th 1851 and found to contain 131^{ac} 110^{ps} & allowance of six per cent for roads &.
