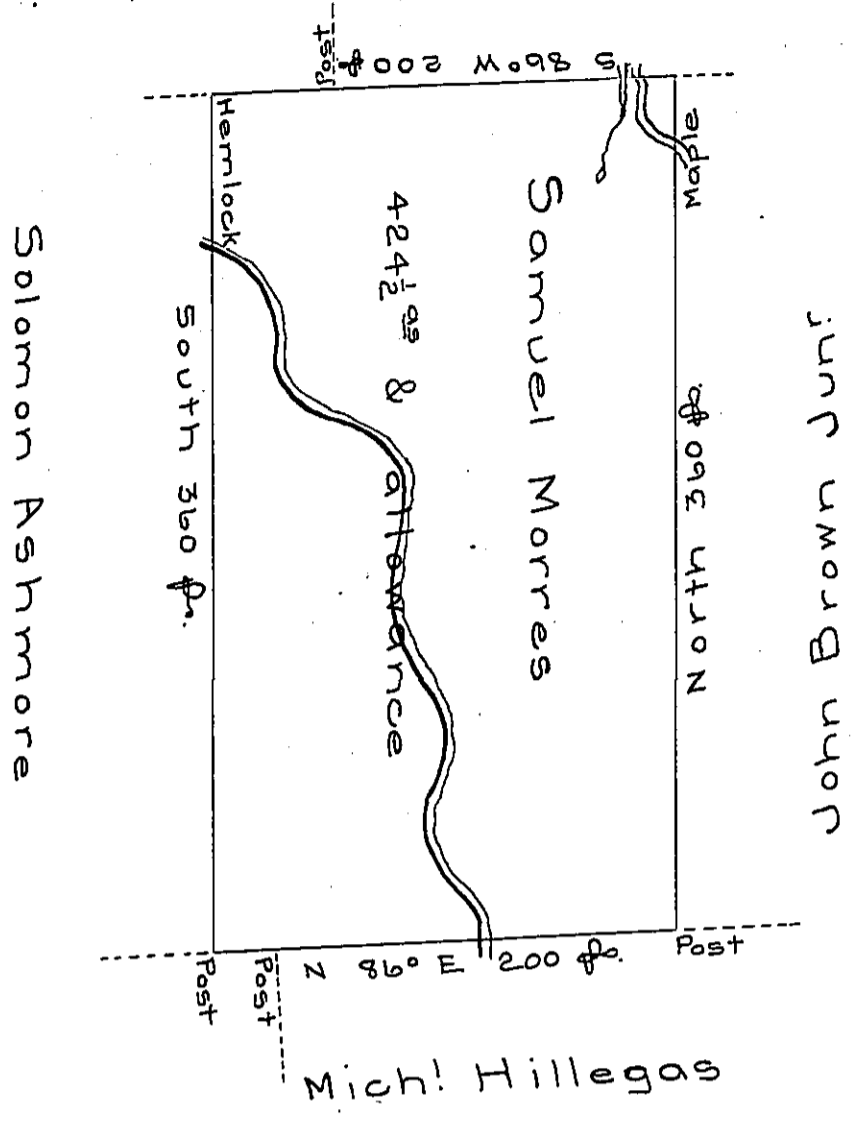


John Brown Senr. Thos. Fitzsimmons
