



Situate on the waters of Licking Creek in Dublin township Bedford County containing two hundred and eight acres thirty four perches and the allowance of six per cent for roads & surveyed the 25 April 1806 on warrant dated the 7<sup>th</sup> April 1806 granted to William M<sup>c</sup> Karrel for 200 acres; by William Piper Esq<sup>r</sup> D.S. and resurveyed according to the old marks upon the ground the 22<sup>d</sup> June 1840.
