



Situate in Walker township, Huntingdon County, containing one hundred and fifty-three acres fifty six perches and allowance of six per centum; being part of a tract of land first surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Piper, dated the 10th Sept. 1762 and a warrant of acceptance dated 22nd July 1766, said to contain 195 A. 53 P. & allow. This part divided from the remainder of said tract, for William Lincoln, January 23rd 1854.
