



The above survey is situated in Henry Clay formerly Wharton township Fayette County surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jno. Mitchel dated March<sup>#</sup> 25<sup>th</sup> 1805 by John Fleming in 1811 resurveyed by John I. Dorsay Esq my predecessor in office in 1833 then claimed by Andrew Mitchel heir and legal representative of John Mitchel the warrantee & sold as unseated in 1836 for taxes to Thomas Patton.
