In pursuance of a warrant dated August 29th 1785 was survey'd for Andrew Robinson the above described tract of land containing three hundred and six acres & 129 perches with an allowance proportioned to six $\frac{1}{2}$ cent situate on the South side of the Alle-gany river adjoining land of Robert Turner and others in Pitt township Westmoreland County survey'd May 19th 1787.
