



A draught of a tract of land surveyed by Joseph J. Wallis 22nd June 1784 then Deputy Surveyor for Northumberland County in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Morrison bearing date 16th August 1773 containing as per return of survey 309 acres 74 perches with the allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Resurveyed on the 24th and 25th days of March 1852 for the purpose of showing interference with the George Dougherty tract of land containing one hundred and seventy six acres and seventy two perches, with the allowance of six per cent for roads &c. situate in Hepburn township Lycoming County Pa.
