



A draught of a tract of land situate at the foot of Bald Eagle Mountain in Nittoney Valley at a place call'd Davis's Gap in Bald Eagle township in the County of Northumberland, survey'd on the 10th day of September 1784 for Charles Risk in pursuance of his warrant bearing date the first day of July 1784 containing four hundred & two acres & one half with the allowance of six p cent for roads, and return'd by special order of the Board of Property &c. — M^o July 1789.
