



Surveyed the above described tract of land on the 6th day of December 1816 by Virtue of Warrant No 4068 granted to Robert Morris dated the 30th of August 1793 Containing Ten hundred and ninety acres and forty perches with the allowance of six per cent Situate in Miflin Township Lycomig County and bounded as above described

(Note by endorsement on said Warrant it appears that Henry Vander-slice high Sherriff of Northumberland County did by virtue of a writ of testatam Fi. Fa. to him directed from the Supreme court of Pennsylvania Leveed on this Warrant as the property of Robert Morris and after giving due Notioⁿ of the time of sale sold it to Thomas Grant on the thirtieth day of August 1802)
