



Situate on the South side of the South West Branch of Dunnings Creek in St Clair township Bedford County Containing 34 acres 23 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &. Being part of 375 acres of Land Surveyed by Richard Tea Deputy Surveyor in June 1765 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 2^d June 1763 granted to Patrick Allison.
