



A Draught obl. a Tract of Land Situate parobly in Macongy and the Remainder obl. Upper Milford Township in the Courty of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania Containing One hundred and twenty five acres and 36 Perches of Land together with the usual allowance at Six per Cent for Roads That was Surveyed unto Jacob Reiber in Pursuance of a Warrant from the Hon<sup>ble</sup>. Proprietaries dated on the 26<sup>th</sup> August Anno 1752 granted to George Mayne who by his agreement dated the 14<sup>th</sup> November Anno 1753 Sold and Conveyed his Right to the same unto him the said Jacob Reibobl.
