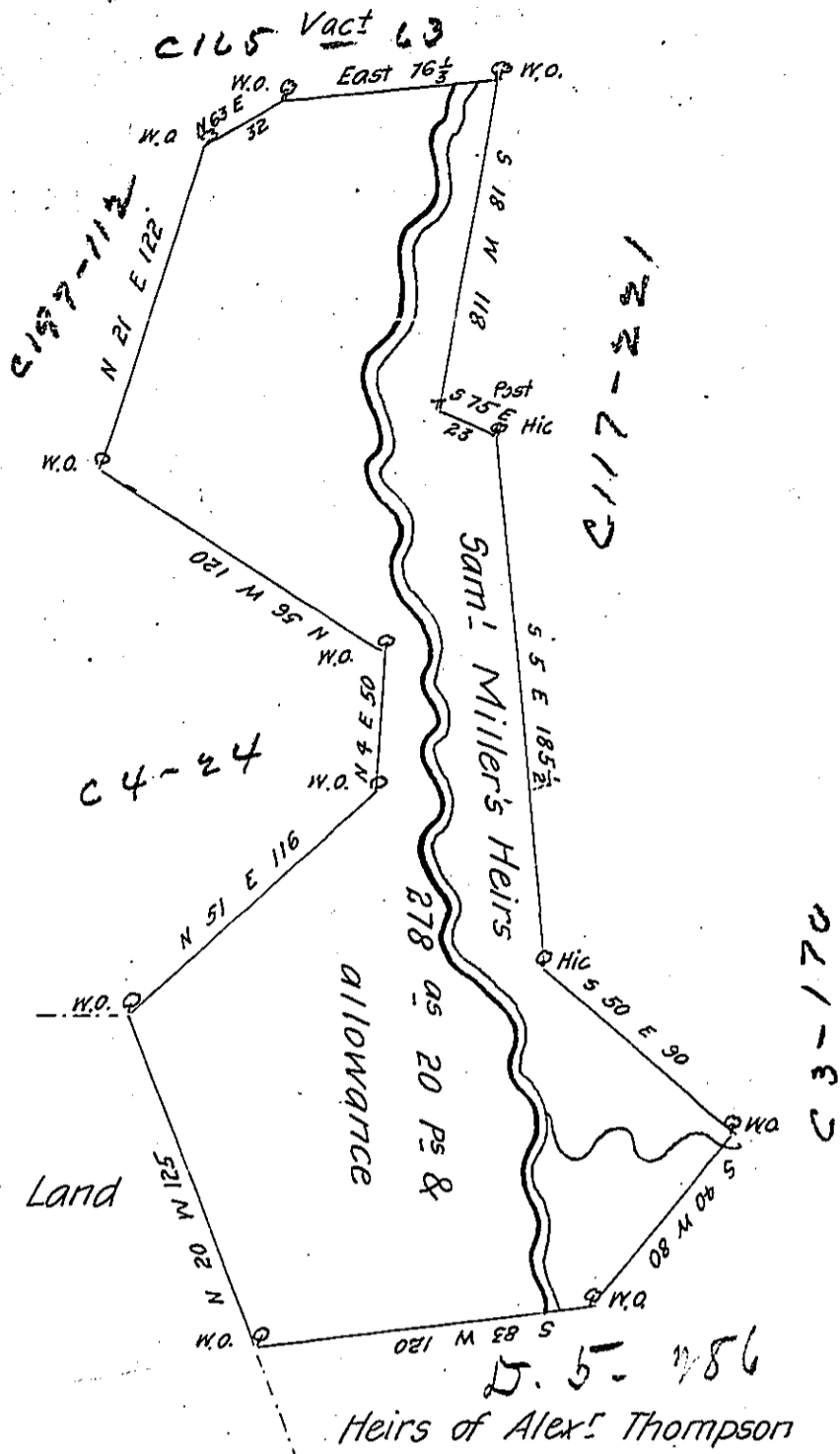

In Pursuance of a Warrant dated Jan<sup>y</sup>-1774 Granted to Samuel Miller there was Survey'd to the Heirs of the said S<sup>dd</sup>. Miller the above described Tract of Land Containing Two Hundred and Seventy eight Acres & Twenty perches with an allowance proportioned to Six P. Cent Situate on both sides of the Baver Run adjoining Land of Matthew Whitehead the Heirs of Alex<sup>s</sup>. Thompson and others in Salem Township Westmoreland Co<sup>ty</sup> Survey'd November 4<sup>th</sup> 1788
