



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of November Anno Dom. 1737 the above described Tract of Land was Surveyed unto James Taylor in Barn Township & in ye County of Lancaster Beginning at a Spruce by Tulpehocken Creek thence North 60 Degrees East by Land Surveyed to Benjamin Cowpland 264 Perches to a chestnut oak &c. Contain Three Hundred & thirty three Acres beside the allowance of Six P. Cent. 20<sup>th</sup> 2<sup>d</sup> m<sup>o</sup> 1738
