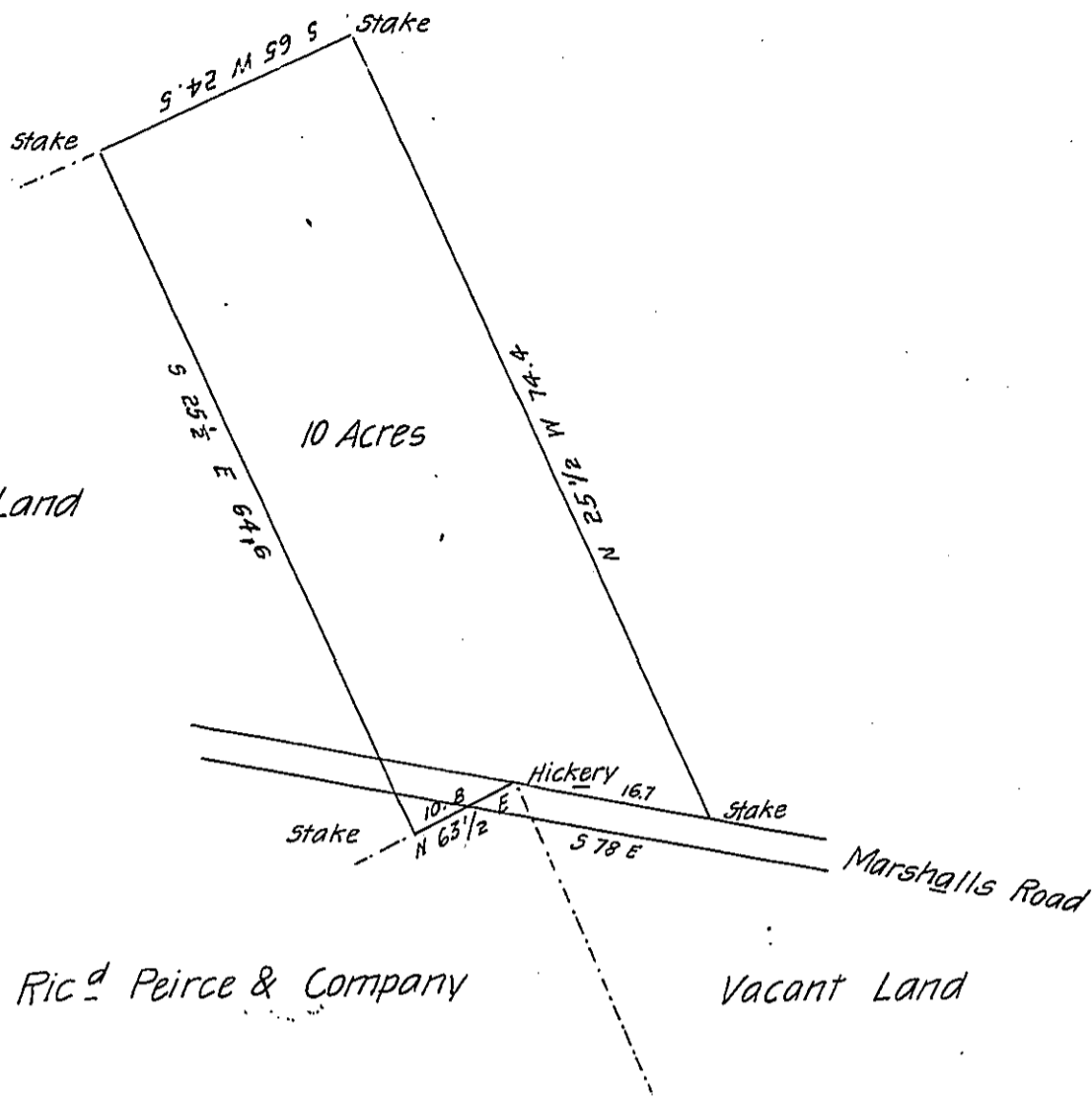

Pursuant to thy orders I have Surveyed 10 Acres of Vacant land within the Western Liberties of ye City of Philad^e. Beginning at a Hickery formerly mark^d Standing on ye North Side of a Road Commonly Ca^led Marshels Road it being a Corner of Ri^{cd} Peirce and Companies Land thence by ye said Road S 78 E 16.7 to a Stake Thence N 25 1/2 W 74.4 to a Stake in ye line of David Seldricks Land thence by ye S^d-Seldricks Line S 65 W 24.5 to a Stake ye Corner of George Emlins Land thence by a line of mark^d Trees dividing this from ye S^d-Emlins Land S 25 1/2 E 64.6 to the line of Land Originally Ri^{cd} Peirce & Company Thence along ye S^d line N 63 1/2 E 10.8 to ye Place of Beginning Containing as above said
