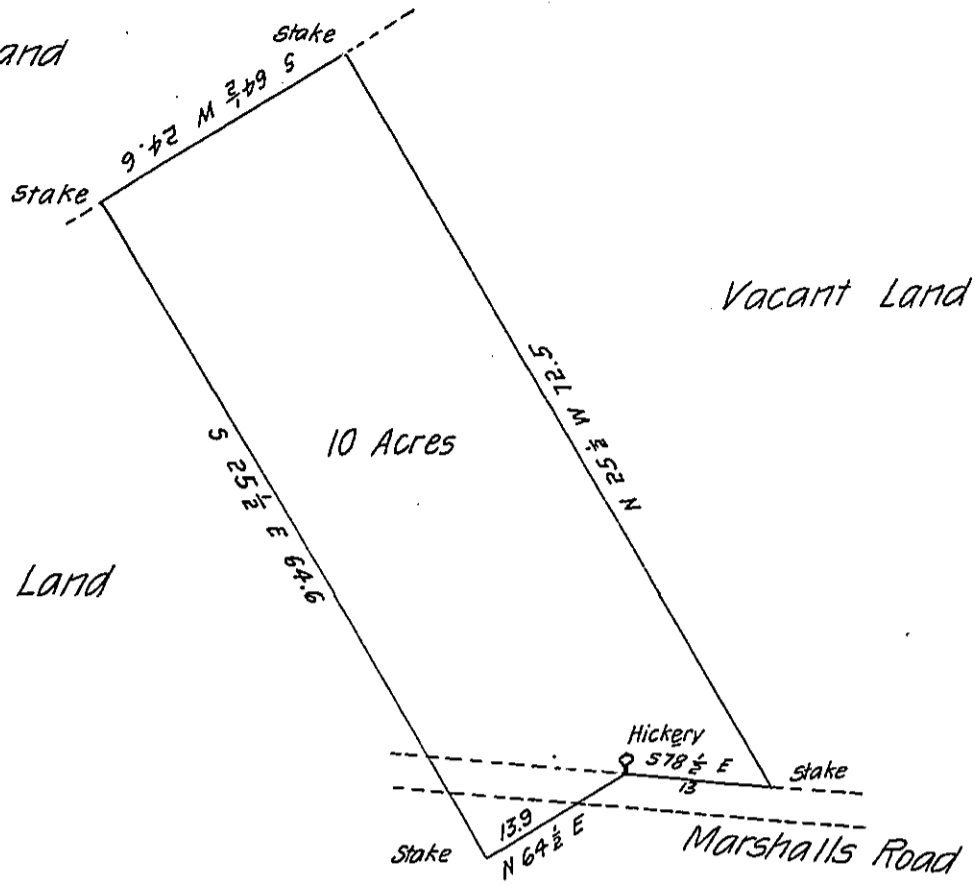

Persuant to an Order to me directed I have Survey^d Ten Acres of liberty land) it being Appurtenant to Land Purchas^d by Robert Jones of Cholesbury in y^e County of Bucks in the Kingdom of England and in answer to a Warrant for the same bearing date y^e 14th day of January Anno Domini 1752 Grant^d to Peter Reeve & Joseph Saunders) Beginning at a Hickery formerly mark^d it being y^e North East Corner of Ric^d Peirce & Company^s land Thence by a Road commonly Call^d Marshalls Road 578¹/₂ E 13 Perches to a Stake Thence by a line of marked trees N 25¹/₂ W 72¹/₂ ^{Pers} to a Stake in a Line of David Seldricks land (formerly Peirce & Watson^s) thence by y^e 5^d—Seldricks land S 64¹/₂ W 24¹/₂ Perches to a Stake Thence by a line of mark^d trees dividing this from George Emlen's land (formerly Pennington and Company^s) S 25¹/₂ E 64.6 Perches to y^e line of land formerly Ric^d Peirce & Company Thence by y^e said line N 64¹/₂ E 13.9 Perches to the Beginning Containing 10 Acres as is above Represented Survey^d y^e 14th day of November
