



Situate in Conewago & Mount Pleasant Townships Adams County surveyed April 21st 1744 by Tho^s Cookson D.S. by Warrant to Henry Neale Dated March 23rd 1742 a part of which was afterwards patented to George Stevenson on warrant to Wm Herr and another part to Tho^s Armor on warrant to Jo^s McKinney Resurveyed Dec^r 29th 1812 for the Conewago Church and the patented parts excluded in pursuance of an order of Resurvey granted Lewis Berth dated Dec^r 8th 1812 containing one hundred & forty one acres one hundred & sixteen perches & alle.
