



A Draught of 302²-129 perches of land with allowance of 6 per Cent for Roads &c. which appears by endorsement on the Warrant to have been Surveyed by Robert Robison D.S. April 25th 1831 in pursuance of a warrant to David-Neely for 270 acres dated March 9th 1787 Examined the North End for Brown Mc Nitt the present owner March 16th 1854 & found the old lines as above represented Containing 173²-47 perches & allowance, The residue of the tract reserved by the old lines on the ground for John B. M. Dowell the present owner Dec. 26th 1854 by John R. Weekes. and found to contain 129²-81 perches and allowance situate in Armagh Township Mifflin County
