A Draught of Thirty nine acres and 80 perches and the allowance of six P^{er} Cent for roads &c. Part of a Larger Tract of Land Situate in Greenwood Township Mifflin County appears survey^d by James Harris late Deputy-Surveyor the 18th day of April 1791 and said to contain 104³/₄ acres &c in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Ray and James Macklin dated the 8th of March 1786.

Divided the 20th of January 1804 agreeable to lines said to have been formerly run for William Ray & James Macklin.
