



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 26<sup>th</sup> of January 1795 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Samuel Rutter for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 4<sup>th</sup>. of January 1794, Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the Waters of Big Beaver Creek adjoining Land granted to David Rutter Called Shine containing four Hundred and twenty four acres three quarters and thirty one poles and the usual allowance of six P. Cent.
