Originally surveyed unto George Gortner in pursuance of his Application No 1124 bearing date October 23^d 1765 As appears by a general draught made by James Scull Late Deputy Surveyor of Berks County, Resurveyed and divided the above for John Nies - the 22^d day of May 1818.
