



By Virtue of an Application dated the 12<sup>th</sup> August 1765, N<sup>o</sup> 452. Surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> June 1769 to Joseph Polliott the above described tract of Land situate in Whitehall Township, Northampton Courty.
