



The above is a Draught of a Tract of Land Situate on the Harges fork of Tennessee Creek, in Washington County. Surveyed June the first 1785 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Col. Andrew Porter Dated Decr 23^d 1784. Called Rattlesneak hill Containing 367 Acres & 64 perches with the usual Allowance of 6 ¹/₂ Cent for Roads &c.
