



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Muncy Creek Township.—Survey'd for Casper Risser in pursuance of a Warrant bearing Date the 12th day of June 1793, by James Armstrong—Who on his Solemn Oath before Jacob Shoemaker, Esq^r, the 15th day of December 1809. Testified that he made the Said survey by order from Joseph J. Wallis, the then Deputy Surveyor of the District about the 5th day of November 1794. And I being earnestly desired to make return of Said Survey (as a matter that has been Neglected) by George Miller the person Interested, have forwarded it with these remarks and Due Submission. Containing Two hundred and Seventeen Acres & Allowance of Six pr. Cent &c.
