Containing one hundred and Fifty three Acres, and 77 perches, ^{Fallowfield} Strict measure, Situate in ~~Nottingham~~ Township W.C. on the Waters of Pigeon Creek. ~ it is owned and occupied by Robert McFarland, (but not Patented) by virtue of a Virginia Certificate, granted to William Parkeson.. Assignee of John Decker. Dated January 26th 1780, to include his Settlement, made in the year 1770 ~ Note, Decker's old settlement, stood at B, the foundation is still to be seen. and the new brick house. Grist mill & Salt works are near the same place, all included in the above Survey. ~
