



By virtue of a Warrant granted to John Patton dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1784 there was resurveyed on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of May 1807 (by Henry M. Richards then Deputy Surveyor) unto George Ege Esquire in right of the said John Patton, the above described tract of land situate in Heidelberg township Berks County containing two hundred and thirty nine acres ten perches and the allowance of six per cent &c.
