



The Draught of a tract of land Situate in Potter Township Centre County Containing four hundred and twenty eight Acres, one hundred & forty six perches and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of December 1817 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Robert Pennington dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of October 1817. The improvement on the above discribed tract of land consists Seven Acres of cleared land a Cabbin dwelling house & Barn an Orchard of Apple Trees, and a family Residing on the same, first improved in March 1807.
