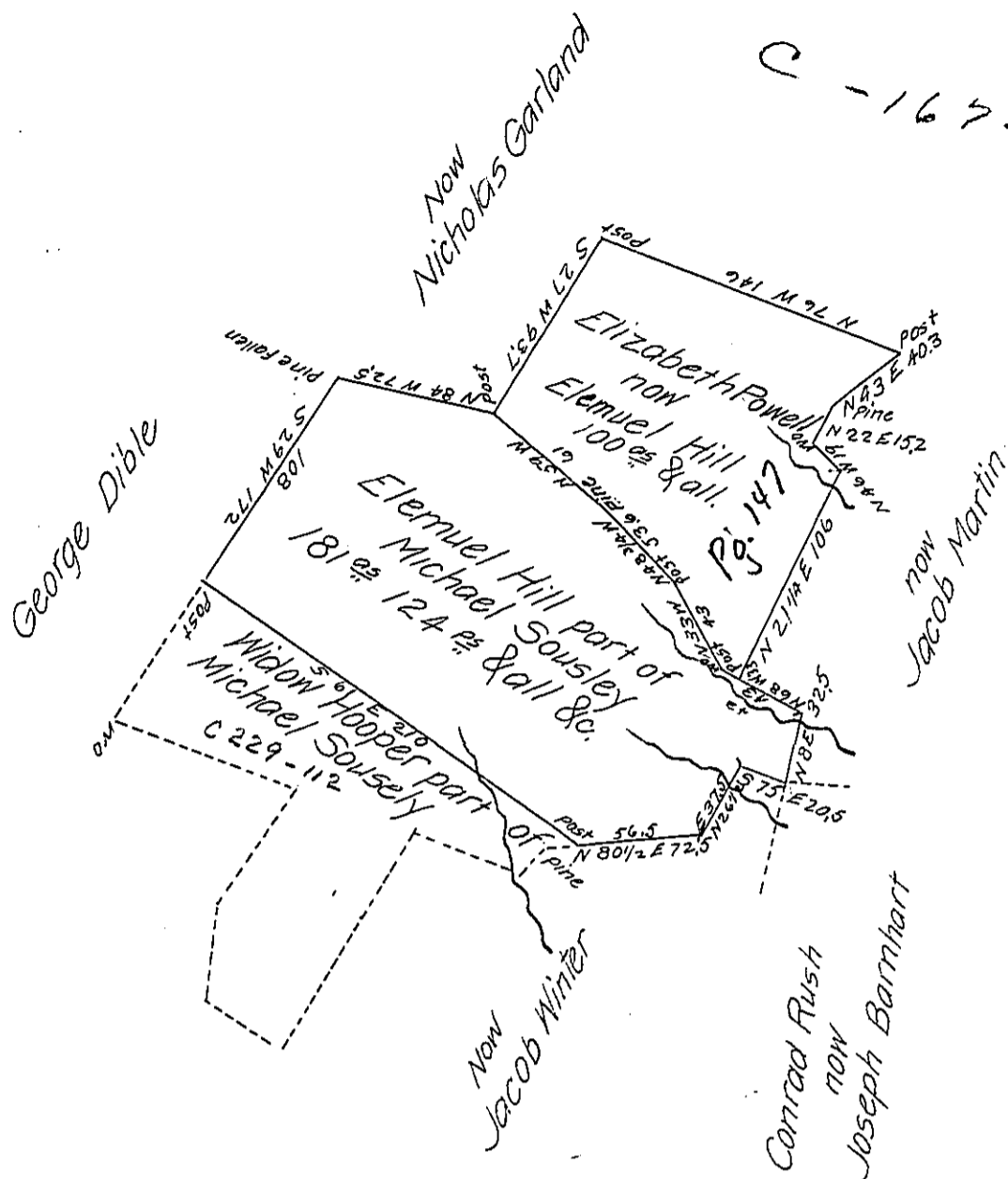

Situate in Bethel township Bedford county containing one hundred and Eighty one acres one hundred and twenty four perches and allowance of six percent for Roads &c Being part of a larger tract of Land containing 257 acres 22 perches & allowance &c. Surveyed for Michael Souseley the 12th Aprile 1792 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 5-May 1789. Surveyed the 16-June 1841 and 11-July 1842 for Elnuel Hill the present occupant and owner according to the old marks upon the ground.
