



The above is the draught of a Survey made April 6<sup>th</sup> 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to James Pearson on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792 Situate Northwest of the Ohio river on the Waters of Beaver Creek adjoining land granted to James Peale Lemner called Cheaps containing 400 acres & with the usual allowance of 6 P Cent &c.
