



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400<sup>ac</sup> dated the 21<sup>th</sup> day of April AD 1794 was surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> day of January 1817 for David Rose the above described Tract of Land Containing 398<sup>2/3</sup> 94 perches and allowance of six per Cent. for Roads &c. and at the time of making said Survey James Lewis was in possession of the same under the above named David Mason and there apered upwards of 20 acres of the Land Cleared & fenced and a house fit for habitation of man &c. situate in venango Township Crawford County Pa
