



*In pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a survey was made on a certain Lot of ground on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772 for Stacey Hepburn situate in the town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general plan of said town number two hundred and sixteen containing in breadth east and west on the south side of Poakberry Street sixty feet and in length North and South two hundred and thirty feet bounded Northward by Poakberry Street Eastward by lot number two hundred and fifteen Southward by Raspberry Alley and Westward by lot number two hundred and seventeen Returned into the Secretary's Office the 22<sup>d</sup> day of March 1776 for William Robbins by warrant dated the 19<sup>th</sup> instant*

*IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirteenth day of JULY 1906*
