



In pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 on a certain Lot of ground situate in the town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said town number two hundred and seventy five containing in breadth East and West on the North side of Hurtleberry street sixty feet and in length North and South two hundred and thirty feet Bounded southward by Hurtleberry street Eastward by lot number two hundred and seventy four Northward by Raspberry Alley and Westward by lot number two hundred and seventy six returned into the Secretary's office the 27th day of March 1776 for Frederick Reely by warrant dated the 21st of the same month

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirteenth day of JULY 1906
