



In pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for Thomas Pollock on a certain lot of ground situate in the town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general plan of said town number seventy eight containing in breadth north and south on the east side of Broad Way fifty seven feet six inches and in length east and west two hundred and thirty feet bounded westw^d by Broad Way northward by lot number seventy seven eastward by River Alley and southward by lot number seventy nine returned into the Secretary's office the 27th day of March for Henry Reichard by warrant dated the 20th of the same month

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirteenth day of JULY 1906
