



A draught of a tract of land called Spring Grove (being part of a larger tract of that name) situate on the head of a run which empties into the east side of Stony Creek about 1 1/2 miles below the mouth of Paint Creek adjoining land of Jacob Musser John Rohra Michael Shank & Stephen Martin & near John Forees land in Brothers Valley Township in the County of Bedford containing two hundred & eighty seven acres and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c surveyed the 12th & 13th days of May 1774 for Christian Rohra in pursuance of a warrant dated the 28th day of December 1773 by
