



A draught of a tract of land called — situate on the easterly side of the north east branch of Susquehanna River about three miles below Nescopeck Falls in the County of Northumberland containing two hundred and seventy seven acres & sixteen perches besides the usual allowance of 6 P cent for roads &<sup>ts</sup> surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June 1773 for Joseph Johnston Mariner in pursuance of an order dated the 22<sup>d</sup> day of August 1769 number 3743
