



A draught of a tract of land called --- situate on a branch running in to the south branch of Roring Creek joining land surveyed for Abel James & others in Augusta township Northumberland County containing three hundred & thirty three acres & 3/4 of an acre besides the usual allowance of six P cent for roads & is surveyed for Daniel Rees the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1776 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of Sept: 1776
