



A draught of a tract of land called Wheatfield situate about 1 1/2 miles southerly from that part of the west branch of Susquehanna — which lies halfway between the mouth of Chest Creek & Clearfield Creek on the waters of Clearfield Creek adjoining land of John Ladd Howell & Richard Humphreys in the County of Bedford containing three hundred & eleven acres ^{8/14} & the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c surveyed the 25th day of November 1775 for Gustaff Risberg in pursuance of a warrant dated the third day of August 1773 by
