



By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietor dated the 22<sup>d</sup> day of October Anno Dom 1737 The above described tract of land was surveyed in Lancaster County unto John Lewis and is situate in Robinson Township, on a branch of French Creek beginning at a white oak thence north 20° west by vacant land 122 perches to a small hickery Thence north 70 degrees east by vacant land 140 perches to a post thence south 20 degrees east by vacant land or the land of widow Roberts 122 perches to a post thence south 70 degrees west by vacant land one hundred and forty perches to the place of beginning.
