



In pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772 for David Plunket on a certain lot of ground situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general plan of said town number two hundred and seventy eight containing in breadth north & south on Broad Way fifty seven feet six inches and in length east and west two hundred and thirty feet bounded westward by Broad Way southward by lot number two hundred and seventy nine Eastward by River Alley and Northward by lot number two hundred and seventy seven returned into the Secretarys office the 9<sup>th</sup> day of November 1776 for Gustavus Ross

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty ninth day of August 1906
