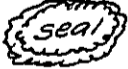


The above is a draught of a tract of land situate near Monongahela River in Washington County called Jacobs Green containing 340 acres of land surveyed May 18<sup>th</sup> 1785 in pursuance of a certificate from the Virginia Surveyors Office in the following words. Virginia Surveyors Office Yohogania County ss:

Jacob Rape produced a certificate from Joseph Holmes Phillip Pendleton and Francis Peyton Gent: Commissioners from & for the state of Virginia to settle titles and grant unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongahela Yohogany & Ohio "in these words" We the Commissioners for adjusting the claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Morgahela Yohogany & Ohio do hereby certify that Jacob Rape is entitled to four hundred acres of land in this County on the waters of Monongahela to include his settlement thereon in the year 1784 given under our hands at Cox's fort the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>y</sup> 1780 signed Francis Peyton Phil Pendleton Joseph Holmes Sam: Erwin Cl: Pro. Temp. which certificate I find entered on the records in my office when under the direction of Col. W<sup>m</sup> Crawford the then County Survey: given under my hand, and seal this 30<sup>th</sup> day of March 1785 Book N<sup>o</sup> 1 Folio 1 entry N<sup>o</sup> 222 signed, B Johnston Syc. Jn: Hoge
