



A draught of a survey lying on the waters of Peters Creek in Washington County containing 343 acs & 60 ps without any allowance executed Decemr 29th 1785 in pursuance of a certificate in these words.

We the commissioners for adjusting claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia York & Ohio do hereby certify that John Jones is intitled to four hundred acs of land in the County of York situate on the waters of Peters Creek to include his settlement made in the year 1772

Given under our hands at Cox's Fort the 5 Febr. 1780 and in the fourth year of ye Commonwealth.
