This is to certify that Henry Rankin & Alex<sup>r</sup> M<sup>o</sup> Bride produced a certificate from the Com<sup>s</sup> appointed to grant lands in the Countys of Yohogania Monongahalia & Ohio for four hundred acres of land on the waters of Raccoon - to include their settlement made in 1774 which entry bears date on my book the 25<sup>th</sup> day of Feb' 1780 (Book N<sup>o</sup> 1 Folio 31) given under my hand & seal 7<sup>th</sup> day of July 1784
