



Survey'd to Henry Read on the ninth day of October 1785 the above described tract of land containing two hundred and fifty four acres and one hundred and twenty one perches with the usual allowance of six P Ct. & situated and lying one mile east of the Alleginey River and about two and one half miles south east from the mouth of Tobys Creek and adjoining lands of William Amberson Northumberland<sup>d</sup> County by warrant dated 11<sup>th</sup> day of August 1785 number 597
